We are especially proud of our delivery of the Biche Secondary School that opened its doors to students on September 5th this year after ten (10) years of lying idle as students travelled far away from their homes to gain an education. This modern secondary school facility caters for five hundred and twenty five (525) students and is comprised of two (2) Classroom blocks, Multi-purpose Hall, Administrative Facilities, Music Room, Computer Room, Audio Visual Room, Library, Cafeteria, Multi-Media Learning Centre, Design Technology Studio Arts & Crafts Room and Science
